6.1 Mayor's Update

Mayor Sartoretto offered congratulations to the Bunker and the Speaker for their joint book release and thanked the Housing and Social Services Committee for the holiday decorations.

Mayor Sartoretto reported on the TeMAG meeting at which topics for discussion included the Forestry Plan, MPAC, the Airport Hanger Sale, and the Highway 11 4-laning. She also announced the events scheduled for November 26, when Agnico will be in Cobalt to unveil a plaque on their original office building, a new sign launching the new name of the Public Library and to host an open house. Additionally, the Timiskaming Foundation will host an event at the Library in the evening.

6.6 Recreation

Councillor Nielsen reported that the recreation survey has been launched. It is available online and at certain locations throughout Town, as well as being distributed in person. Distribution to each household has been very time consuming and labour intensive. Amanda Mongeon of the Health Unit was thanked for her assistance.

She also reported that the ONTC Christmas Train is returning to Cobalt again this year, on December 3, 2015 from 6-700pm. The train will stop south of the station. Santa will be in the boxcar and treat bags will be handed out. Attendees are asked to bring non-perishable food items for the food bank. An anonymous donation of \$100 has been received for the event.

Councillor Nielsen suggested that during the user fee review, that a senior's discount ought to be considered at the Hoist Room.

Councillor Nielsen announced that she has joined a YMCA Feasibility Study Committee for South Temiskaming.

The Recreation Committee will explore options for an outdoor rink.
