

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBALT

BY-LAW NO. 2008-012

BEING a By-law to prohibit the depositing of snow on any highway or bridge within the Town of Cobalt.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, Section 11(3) empowers municipalities to pass by-laws regarding highways;


AND WHEREAS the definition of highways includes all streets, public laneways and public sidewalks;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBALT HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That no person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice upon any portion of any highway or bridge located within the territorial limits of THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COBALT.
2. That no person shall clear away or remove snow from a highway, except as may be necessary to clear away snow blocking access to a private entrance or driveway.
3. That no person shall move snow within the street allowance from one side of the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular traffic and pedestrian traffic, to the other side of the street allowance.
4. That no person shall relocate snow within the street allowance in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, or that would result in the obstruction of normal visibility of the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the street allowance.
5. That any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and subject to a fine recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.

READ a third time and passed this 8th day of April 2008.
