

Property Taxes are calculated using the assessed value of your property and multiplying it by the municipal and tax rate(s) for your property class. The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) determines the value of your property and is shown on property assessment notices sent to each property owner by MPAC. Education tax rates are set by the Government of Ontario and are also applied to your assessed property value. The Town of Cobalt collects the education portion of property taxes and then remits to the school boards based on a Ministry of Education formula.

- If you have a change of address, please notify the Municipal Office as soon as possible to fill out a "Mailing Address Change Form". Bills will only be sent to the address currently on file.
