To deter animals from your bins, please consider:

- Keeping your garbage containers inside a garage or a shed
- If you're unable to place the containers inside, regularly wash to help reduce odors
- Placing your garbage at the curb or roadside by 6:30 a.m. on collection day, not the previous evening
- Putting meat scraps in the freezer until collection day

Payments made at the banks, by internet or telebanking shall be recorded as received by the Town on the date received by the Town's bank. Electronic payments normally require **2 to 3 business days** to process and ratepayers are responsible for allowing their financial institution processing time to submit the payment to the Town.

Not Receiving your Tax Bill?

If your property tax bill does not have the correct mailing address, it may not be delivered to you. Please ensure that we have your up to date mailing address on file for all your properties within the Municipality of Cobalt.

If you have a change of address, please notify the Municipal Office as soon as possible in person or by emailing <u>cobalt@cobalt.ca</u>. Bills will only be sent to the address currently on file.

Tax Sale Policy

Municipal Property Tax Policy By-Law 2020-32:

If you do not pay your 2023 tax bill <u>in full by</u> <u>December 31, 2024</u>, your property will be placed in **Tax Registration** in accordance with proceedings prescribed by the *Municipal Act. 2001* and *Ontario Regulations* 181/03 for **Municipal Tax Sale**. Significant fees apply to this process and all interested parties including mortgage companies and financial institutions will be notified.
